### QUALIFICATIONS

In order to be successful in the Props Department, we suggest that you have one or more of the following. Please check off which qualifications you possess and include this form along with your application:

- Two years of education at the post secondary level in a school of theatre design or theatre crafts, or two years of education at the post secondary level in a school of broadcast communications specializing in television or film with an emphasis on design.
- Two years of employment experience with a television set decoration or properties department.
- Two years of employment experience with a professional theatre company in props or set decoration.
- Two years of continuous volunteer experience with a community broadcaster or theatre with an emphasis in props.
- Two years of employment in the motion picture industry in another province, state or country in either props or set decorating.
- Any related education, experience, special or valuable skills, please provide details.

### The applicant must also possess the following:

- Proof of Current WHMIS Instruction/Training
- Proof of attendance at a Set Orientation course  
(Contact Film Training Manitoba at 989-9669 for course dates)
- Proof of any related experience and education
- Intro to Paper course ( Film Training Manitoba)

**MEMBERSHIP:** In order to be considered for membership, the applicant must work a minimum of 60 days in the Props Department on two or more IATSE Local 856 productions, have Set Orientation, WHMIS, Basic First Aid, Collective Agreement and Health & Welfare Seminar. Two letters of Reference from 2 different IATSE Local 856 Property Masters are also required.

**UPGRADE OR CROSSOVER:** In order to be considered for upgrade/crossover, the applicant must work a minimum of 60 days in the Props Department under Local 856 and meet the above qualifications. As a requirement for Membership, the Applicant should have worked on 2 productions and supply 2 Letters of Reference from 2 different IATSE Property Masters. The Collective Agreement and Health & Welfare Seminaris required for upgrades into Key Positions.
