To apply for status in the Construction Department, please check off which tools you possess/any information, which applies, and include this form along with your Application.

CARPENTER – An applicant should have proof of:

- At least 6 years experience (or Journey-person ticket)
- A background in framing
- A background in finishing carpentry (wainscoting, crown moulding, cornice work)
- Proficient in building straight/curved stairs
- Blueprint reading for layout & material cutting lists
- Familiarity with jig design
- Millwork an asset

CARPENTER'S ASSISTANT – Based on qualifications most closely matching the above

LABOURER – Applicants for this position should have proof of experience in construction and be in good physical condition. Applicants must have a valid Drivers License and be able to drive a 1 Ton truck. Duties include organizing and stacking of materials as well as safely and carefully loading and unloading finished sets from trucks. A Labourer will be responsible for neatly laying out power lines, airlines, and power tools, etc. as well as the correct storage and inventory of the same. Must have self-initiative in clearing and cleaning up debris in construction shop and on sets. Must be able to operate skyjacks and work from scaffolding. First Aid training is an asset.

Specific Requirements/Minimum Qualifications:

Membership – Applicants for Membership must demonstrate all of the following:

- 1 60 Days working on a minimum of 2 IATSE Local 856 films in the department (in the position applying for)
- 2 Letters of recommendation from 2 different Construction Department Keys/Heads (at least one must be a Local 856 Member)
- 3 Set Orientation course
- 4 Intro to Paper Course
- 5 Valid Class 5 Drivers License
- 6 Proof of Current WHMIS Instruction/Training
- 7 Basic First Aid
- 8 Collective Agreement and Health & Welfare Seminar

Department Transfer – Applicants for Department Transfer must demonstrate the following:

- 1 Must be a Member in Good Standing
- 2 Set Etiquette course
- 3 Proof of Current WHMIS Instruction/Training
- 4 Valid Drivers License
- 5 Must have at least 60 Days related experience (ex. Non-Film Carpentry)
- 6 60 Days working on a minimum of 2 IATSE Local 856 films in the department (in the position applying for)

Members Upgrading – Members wishing to upgrade their classifications must demonstrate the following:

- 1 60 Days working on a minimum of 2 IATSE Local 856 films in the department (in the position applying for)
- 2 Letters of recommendation from 2 different Construction Department Keys/Heads (at least one must be a Local 856 Member)
- 3 A member in good standing
- 4 Collective Agreement and Health & Welfare Seminar (required if upgrading into Key position)
