This could include unloading trucks, moving set dressing onto the sets (everything from fake toxic waste to fine antiques) and marking every piece of set dressing according to ownership.

- Education in fine art, carpentry, design, interior design, art conservation, anthropology, materials, technical production, painting, film making, drapery upholstery, floral design, etc.
- Work, trade, or volunteer related experience in theatre, display, video, costume, paint, carpentry, independent film, student films, interior design, commercials, and photo shoot styling.
- Ability to take direction and work well within groups.
- Good verbal and written communication skills are necessary for all positions.
