

SET DECORATING DEPARTMENT APPLICATION QUALIFICATIONS

Thank you for your interest in the Set Decorating Department of IATSE Local 856. The Set Decorating Department can be very creative and exciting but involves a lot of hard work! Please take a few moments to read the following and assess your qualifications before filling out an application.

KEY POINTS TO CONSIDER WHEN COMPLETING AN APPLICATION FORM

- We will not consider applications that are not filled out correctly and completely, or are missing information. Please use this guide to complete your application and resume.
- All applicants must include a current resume detailing education, work history, specific skills, and related interests.
- Film and theatre work should include the production title, department head, job title, and days worked.
- Be sure to attach the required checklists to your application.

A BRIEF SUMMARY OF HOW THE PERMITTEE STATUS PROGRAM WORKS

Potential Set Decorating Permittees are expected to have acquired necessary job skills before applying for permittee status. A panel made up of members from various departments reviews all applications and selects those with sufficient skills to be listed on the Permittee list. When the Local 856 Set Decorating membership roster is depleted, listed permittees may be hired by Set Decorating departments (through the Local 856 Business Agent) to fill positions.

SOME QUALIFICATIONS WE LOOK FOR WHEN RECRUITING NEW PERMITTEES

- Education in fine art, carpentry, design, interior design, art conservation, anthropology, materials, technical production, painting, film making, drapery upholstery, floral design, etc.
- Work, trade, or volunteer related experience in theatre, display, video, costume, paint, carpentry, independent film, student films, interior design, commercials, and photo shoot styling.
- Good physical condition, ready, willing, and able to work in a wide variety of circumstances and weather conditions and work well within a group. As a permittee you will start at the "Set Dec Crew" level where you will be expected to do labour intensive jobs. This could include unloading trucks, moving set dressing onto the sets (everything from fake toxic waste to fine antiquities) and marking every piece of set dressing according to ownership.
- Tou must be available anytime night and day for periods up to fourteen hours (or more).
- You must be able to take direction and work well within groups.
- Good verbal and written communication skills are necessary for all positions.
- Somputer skills are an asset.
- You must be familiar with the responsibilities and positions within the Set Decorating department (These are listed in your Permittee Application Information package).



MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE SET DECORATING DEPARTMENT

- □ Intro to Paper course

- □ A valid Driver's License must be able to drive a 1 ton truck

- □ 60 days working on a minimum of 2 IATSE 856 Films in the Set Decorating department.
- Letters of reference from 2 different Set Decorating or Art Department Keys.

DEPARTMENT TRANSFER

- □ Set Orientation course.
- □ Proof of Current WHMIS Instruction/Training
- □ 60 days working on a minimum of 2 IATSE Films in the Set Decorating Department.
- Letters of reference from 2 different Set Decorating department Keys.

REQUIREMENTS FOR UPGRADING WITHIN THE SET DECORATING DEPARTMENT

- □ 60 days working on a minimum of 2 IATSE Films in the position you are applying for.
- □ Letters of recommendation from 2 different immediate supervisors you have worked under (example: Lead Dresser, Set Decorator, Art Director or Production Designer)
- □ Proof of current WHMIS Instruction/training and Set Orientation Course.
- Collective Agreement and Health & Welfare Seminar (required for upgrade to Key position)
