## **MEDIC**

Requires a current First Aid designation Certificate that qualifies them as an Advanced (Advanced First Aider or Emergency Medical Responder with CPR Level BLS and Oxygen Administration).

A Set Medic provides advanced first aid or advanced emergency medical assistance to individuals involved with TV or film productions. As a Set Medic, you work on set with actors and other production crew. Your responsibilities include waiting or standby for medical issues that arise during shooting. Other duties may include advising the production team on safety issues and Covid-19 Health & Safety protocols and procedures. In the event of an emergency or accident, the Set Medic is the first responder and should be right on top of any minor or major accident or injury. They are the primary health resource on set and should be prepared as such. Must be able to clearly fill out multiple medical reports and have proficient communication skills. Set Medics should be equipped with the necessary set medic kit supplies and equipment in case of emergency. This may include resuscitation and trauma equipment, automatic external defibrillator, epi pens, oxygen, cervical collars, and kits for both severe and simple injuries. Must also have all basic first aid supplies.

All medical equipment shall be furnished by the Company or may be supplied by the Key Set Medic via a rental agreement.
